

CATS FARE STRUCTURE

Below is a breakdown of CATS current fares for all routes, except the 16 Capitol Park Shuttle, which is free for all riders.

Adults	\$1.75
Children younger than 5	Free <small>with paying adult</small>
Youth 5 to 18 <small>(Children younger than 12 must be accompanied by an adult)</small>	\$0.35
Senior citizens <small>(ages 62 and older)</small> and people with disabilities who show a CATS ID card	\$0.35
STUDENT DISCOUNT	
Students ride FREE with a valid Southern University, Louisiana State University, or BRCC ID card. School requests for bulk ID cards can be submitted to CATScustomerservice@brcats.com	
31-Day Pass <small>(Unlimited rides for 31 Days)</small>	\$56.00
7-Day Pass <small>(7-Day Passes can be used for unlimited rides for 7 days)</small>	\$19.00
15-Ride Pass <small>(15-Ride Pass is for 15 one-way rides. This pass does not expire until 15 single rides have been used by the pass holder)</small>	\$24.50
15-Senior / Disabled Ride	\$5.25
All-Day Week Passes (Mon - Fri) <small>(All-day week passes can be used an unlimited number of times for a time period of 24 hours from the time of purchase)</small>	\$4.00
All-Day Weekend Passes (Sat & Sun) <small>(All-day weekend passes can be used an unlimited number of times for a time period of 24-hours from the time of purchase)</small>	\$2.00

BUS TRANSFERS:

Bus Transfers are valid for two hours only. After the two-hour window, full fare is required to ride the bus. A transfer cannot be used for the same line.

Transfer fare for a second bus	\$0.25
Subsequent transfers	\$0.25 each

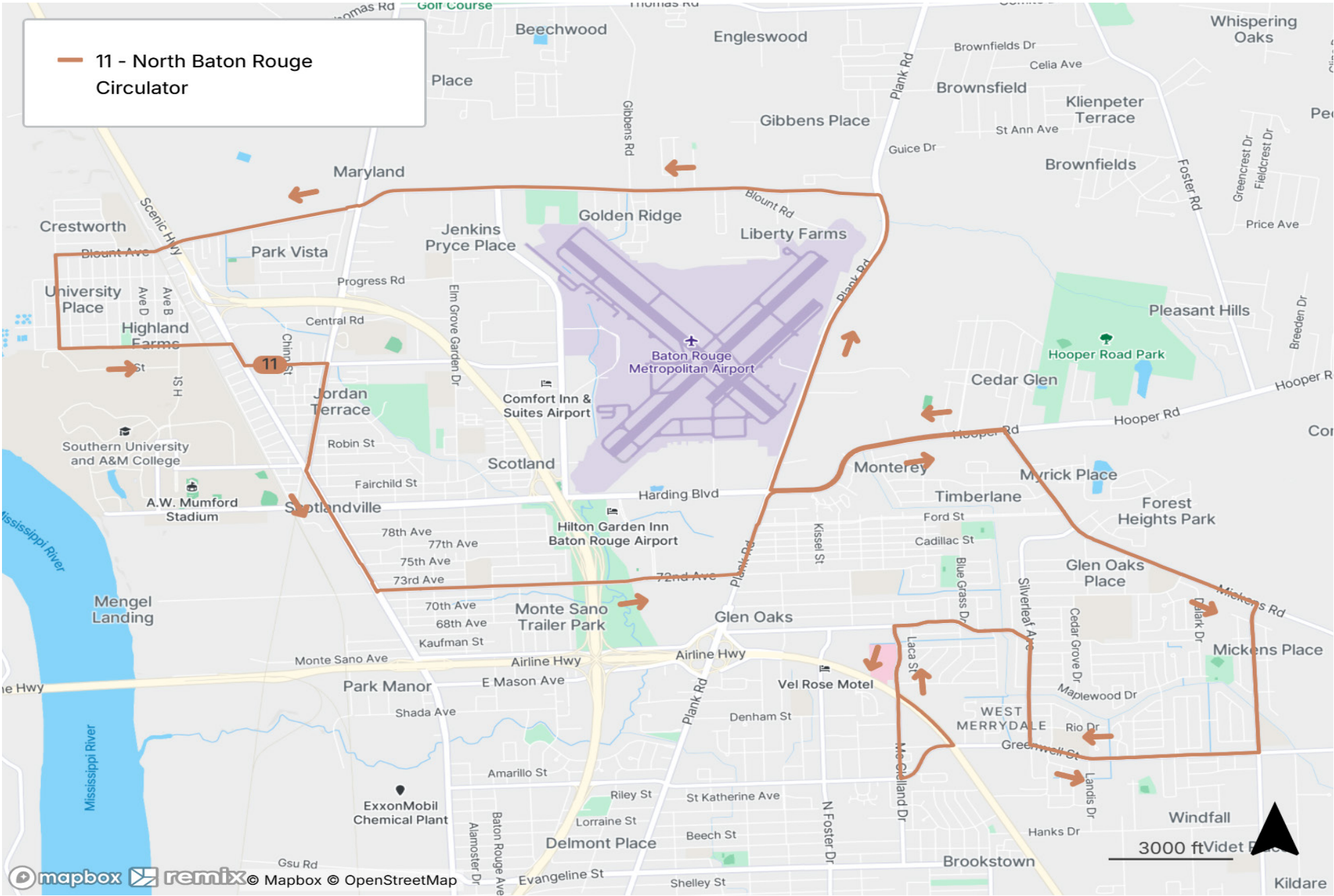
