UTILITY SUPERVISOR

Summary/Objective

The Utility Supervisor is expected to perform, but not be limited to, the duties of the Utility Class "A" position. He/She must be able to clean, fuel, check oil & water buses properly and record the same. He/She should have knowledge of the uses of the automatic bus washing and sweeping equipment and the forklift. He/She will also oversee the removal and installation of the cash boxes into the fare boxes in the evening. He/She is responsible to see that the buses are cleaned for the following day.

Qualifications

- A high school diploma or equivalent and three years' experience in transit with at least one year in supervisory/management capacity in any field and at least two years as an operator with CATS.
- A valid Louisiana Commercial Driver's License & DOT Medical Card is required.
- Transit and/or fleet experience

Essential Duties

Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):

- Oversee the fueling, cleaning and sanitizing of revenue vehicles
- Make sure that the buses are properly probed when the buses come in
- Report any defects or issues with the vehicles and/or equipment to the evening mechanic supervisor



- He/She may need to assist in maintaining the building & grounds especially where Building B (wash bay) and Building C (detail bay) are concerned
